MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Between

KatwaCollege,Katwa,PurbaBardhaman, Pin-713130, West Bengal, India.

And

Society for Mental Health CareAnandaniketan P.O-Khajurdihi, Purba Bardhaman, Pin-713150, West Bengal, India.

This Agreement is made on the 15.04.2024, between Katwa College, (hereinafter referred to as KC) situated at Katwa Duck Banglow Road. Katwa, Purba Bardhaman, Pin-713130, represented by its Principal. Dr. Nirmalendu Sarkar as the first party and Society for Mental Health CareAnandaniketan(hereinafter referred to as SMHC)P.O-Khajurdihi, Purba Bardhaman, Pin-713150, represented by its Secretary, Mr. Subrata Sinha, as the second party, and both the institutions will together be referred to as the parties.

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Whereas

a. Katwa College, hereinafter referred to as KC, founded in 16.08.1948, coeducational college at Katwa aided by UGC & State Government and accredited by NAAC for the Second Cycle, offering BA/B.SC/B.Com. in Arts/Science/Commerce & B.Ed. under the University of Burdwan.

Whereas

- a. Society for Mental Health Care Anandaniketan, hereafter referred to as SMHC. founded under Society Registration Act WBXXVI of 1961 in the year on 1.11.1989 of 1988-1989. It provides the best social service for particularly persons with disabilities, orphan and mental health sector committed as ever to achieve its mission.
- b. KC is desirous to associate with SMHC on various areas as discussed in the purview of this MoU, which will be mutually beneficial to both the institutions.

That, relying on the principle of good faith, by virtue of which they will carry out all the possible actions for their due to fulfillment, and also relying on their common bonds and concerns, they state their interest in strengthening their relationships through cooperation, and to this end they are of one accord in entering this MoU.

THEREFORE, THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:

1. SCOPE &OBJECTIVE OF THE MOU

Both parties agree that the objective of the present MoU is to establish cooperation in order to collaborate towards community awareness development of students. It promotes the motivational awareness towards the disabilities and mental health.

2. METHOD FOR ACHIEVING THE OBJECTIVES

In order to achieve the aforementioned objectives, the parties, in mutual agreement, shall develop social educational programmes and projects that will specify the commitments; each of them is to make for the performance of the said programmes.

3. AREAS OF COOPERATION:

Whereas, **KC** and SMHC agree to collaborate in the field of social awareness particularly mental health and disabilities. Following the purpose of the said agreement, the two parties shall engage in the activities stated below:

- 1. Sensitization of students of KC towards Persons with Disabilities.
- 2. Awareness regarding inclusion in educational, social and vocational areas of socially disadvantage people.
- 3. Development of mental health awareness among the young adults
- 4. Student Development Programmes.
- 5. Games & Sports, Social and cultural programmes.
- 6. Training and capacity building activities as well as internship activities in short term basis.
- 7. Sharing of various craft and vocational activities
- 8. Collaborations for Seminars/Webinars/Workshops.
- 9. Extension Activities with focus on environment by plantation programme.
- 10. Social action (community development).
- 11. Sharing of Infrastructure.









4. FUNDING

- a. Expenses for maintaining infrastructure shall be borne by the respective institutions. The transportation and personal expenses of exchanging students, teachers or officers shall be covered by respective individuals/ Institutions.
- b. Financial expenses for internships of professors and researchers, which will be arranged at the parties' request, as well as travel expenses, shall be

covered by the requesting institution/s. No fees will be paid, to the professors/researchers as they remain in their positions at their home institution, which will continue to pay their salaries.

5. NO EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP

This MoU does not cover any employment provision between KC and SMHC.

6. ACCREDITATION/ CERTIFICATION

The Institution shall issue certification recognizing the achievements of the students, on the basis of hours invested on projects/papers and outreach programs successful completion of Add-On Courses of the enrolled students.

This agreement is a statement of intentions and does not involve, in any instance whatsoever, any financial obligations between the participating institutions

7. TERM

This MOU shall be effective for a period of five (5) years from the date of execution of this agreement, and shall be automatically renewed thereafter for another five (5) years unless a written notice to terminate or amend this agreement is given to the other party, six(6) months in advance.

8. CONFLICT RESOLUTION

Any dispute resulting from the interpretation or application of this Agreement shall be settled through direct negotiation and **common agreement** by the persons delegated to such end by each Institution. Either party may propose to the other a modification of the Agreement at any time in writing.

9. CONFIDENTIALITY

The agreement is strictly confidential. Confidentiality to be maintained for sanctity of MoU.









10. AMENDMENTS

If any amendment requires for addition or and deletion both of the parties willsit together (no third party will be allowed) and they will mutually decide and agree upon the subject.

And, since both parties are in agreement regarding the content of the present document, and as a token of conformity, we sign it in two counterparts, both of which will be considered originals.
