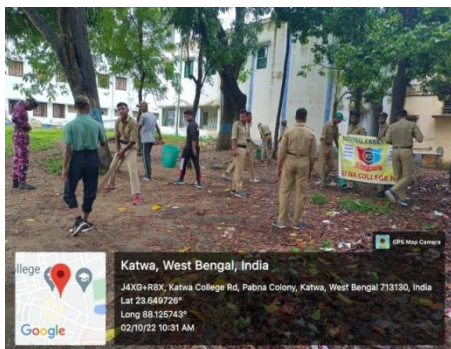

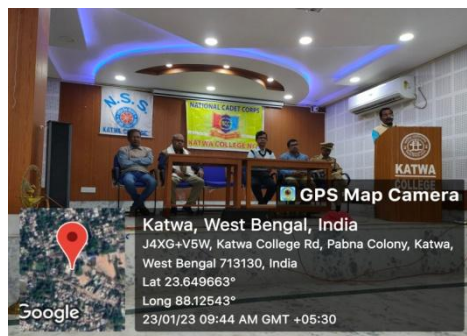

He started a newspaper called Swaraj and started printing a lot against the British rule and the work being done by him. People became more aware and started supporting Subhash Chandra for those tasks which he was doing. He was known as a great leader, and this is why he managed to manage a great youth army easily. He was brave to fight with a powerful British army, and it is worth noting that Subhash Chandra Bose had a great hand in India's freedom fight. The people of India know that Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose had done a lot for him, but in fact his deeds were so important, nobody is aware of it. 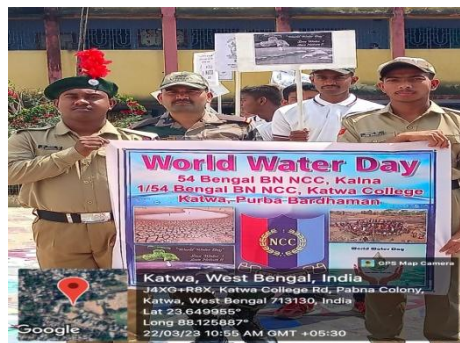
