Merit Point Calculation Method

Percentage of Aggregate = [Marks in Best five Subjects]/5, if total marks is 500.

= [Marks in Best four subjects + Marks in Language]/5, if total marks is 400

- 1. For English, Sanskrit, Mathematics, Chemistry Honours

 Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate + 2(Marks in the respective subject in H.S. Level)
- 2. For Bengali, Geography, Physics, Political Science Honours
 Percentage of Aggregate + Marks in the respective subject in H.S. Level
 3. For History Honours
- Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate + 2(Highest Marks in History or in English in H.S. Level or = Percentage of Aggregate + 2(Marks in English when the respective subject is absent) 4. For Botany, Physiology Honours,

Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate + Marks in Biology in H.S. Level

5. For Zoology Honours

Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate + Marks in Biology in H.S. Level + Marks in Chemistry in H.S. Level

6. For Philosophy Honours

Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate + Highest Marks in the respective subject or in English in or = Percentage of Aggregate + Marks in English when the respective subject is absent 7. For Economics and Accountancy Honours,

Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate + Highest Marks in the respective subject or Mathematics in H.S. Level or = Percentage of Aggregate + Marks in Mathematics when the respective subject is absent 8. For Pure Science General, Bio Science General, Arts General,

Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate

9. For Arts General with Geography

Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate + Marks in the Geography in H.S. Level

10. For B. Com General,

Merit Point = Percentage of Aggregate
